Have you been booed before? If not, let me show you how small acts of kindness can build up the community within your school or in your neighborhood. I am a local children's author who has just published the book *Booing: A Halloween Tradition*, along with a Boo Kit. What is a Boo Kit you ask? The Boo Kit includes a hard cover copy of *Booing: A Halloween Tradition*, the "You've Been Booed" poem, Wisp the ghost, and a suction cup to hang him from your window. Wisp lets others know that you have been booed.

What is booing you ask?

How to Boo in Your School

1. Have students prepare something for another class like a bag of treats or something they are working on in class. Students could write a story, draw a picture, construct something, provide geographical clues to their whereabouts...the possibilities are endless. Have fun with it!
2. Attach a copy of "You've Been Booed" to the teacher's computer or desk.
3. Deliver your items when the other class is at gym, music, or lunch. Be quiet and sneaky. Don't let them see you! (Make sure they do not have a ghost hanging in their window. If they do, you'll know they have already been booed.)
4. Watch and listen to the joy you bring to friends in other classes. Remember to keep your act of kindness a secret.
5. Watch to see how far and quickly the boo spreads!
6. When your classroom gets booed, hang your ghost in the window.

How to Boo in Your Neighborhood

1. Prepare two bags of treats. Include Halloween candy, goodies, crafts, and/or toys. Get creative!
2. Attach a copy of "You've Been Booed" to the front of each bag.
3. After dark, place the two treat bags you created on two of your neighbors' or friends' porches. (Make sure that do not have a ghost hanging in their window. If they do, you'll know they have already been booed.) Be sneaky and don't let them see you!
4. Ring the doorbell, RUN, and HIDE!
5. Watch and listen to the joy you bring to your neighbors/friends as they find the treats on their porch.
6. Watch to see how far and quickly the boo spreads!

Help me spread a little cheer and bring some fun back into our schools and neighborhoods during the Halloween season. I would love the opportunity to read my boo
